#### **General Rules**

• This is a brief guide on Student Village (SV) rules and regulations. The residents can read the full guidelines and rules of occupancy at our Student Village Handbook available in the Swinburne website.

#### **Communal Properties**

- Residents must not interfere with or damage any common or in-room property, nor leave anything on or obstruct the use of common properties. Residents are liable for any damage or lost caused by them.
- Residents must ensure to observe full responsibility and considerate to others when using common facilities such as washroom, kitchen, laundry and common lounge.

#### Restriction of Entering Residence

 Male and Female hostel are separated from each other and **no opposite gender** are allowed to enter the restricted block at all-time.

#### Area Curfew

 Residents are not allowed to sit and gather at the central foyer & outdoor seating area (outside of dining hall, outdoor area in between SV1, SV2 and SV3, and outside SV2 and SV3) from 12.00 am - 7.00 am.

#### **Room Ettiquette**

- Keep the room clean and tidy.
- Compulsory use of mattress protector at all time.
- Defacing the walls, equipment, furniture's, etc. is strictly prohibited.
- Must turn off all lights and electrical equipment before leaving the room.
- Changing room furniture positions without approval is strictly prohibited.
- Only White/Blue-tack is allowed to be used for sticking note/material on any room surfaces (furniture, wall, etc)
- Must ensure all room equipment, furniture and fitting including beddings returned to good conditions before check-out.
- Must ensure room is not left with debris before check-out.

#### Smoking

We are smoke free campus. Smoking and vaping is not allowed in the Student Village (SV) and whole campus.

#### **Noise Curfew**

- All residents must observe consideration for their neighbours to rest, study and sleep after 11 pm.
- Singing, talking loudly, playing loud music, group gathering or any activity caused excessive noise is strictly prohibited from 11.00 pm until 8.00 am.

#### **Rules of Occupancy**

Student Village Rules of Occupancy promote tolerance, courtesy and care for others and the different needs within the community. Its important for their residents to fully observe the rules and regulations. Appropriate actions will be taken to residents who disregards the rules and regulations at Student Village.

In addition to other rules as outlined in the Resident Handbook, residents will be immediately evicted If they are:

- Found smoking and vaping in the premises.
- Found to be carrying, using or distributing drugs or other illegal substances.
- Found to be involved in the harassment of or discrimination against another resident, staff member or person.
- Found to be involved in the sexual and/or physical abuse of another resident, staff member or person
- Found to be involved in theft of another person's property.

#### Access Door Card

The access door card should be carried by residents at all times for use at main turnstile entrance and room.

RM50.00 charge for replacement of lost/broken access card.

#### **Alcohol and Non-Halal Food**

- Under no circumstances are residents permitted to bring in, stored and consume alcohols within the Student Village. This includes cooking wine for cooking purposes in kitchen.
- Non-halal food such as pork are not allowed to be prepared, stored and consumed in common areas such as pantry, fridge, kitchen. Items found will be discarded. Student can only consumed non-halal in their own room.
- Appropriate actions will be taken to residents who disregards the rules.

#### Lock-Out (first time only)

After office hour—Please call or find Resident Advisor/Male or Female warden at their units.

Penalty RM10 will be given to assist opening the door for second time lock-out request.

#### **Amenities & Services**

Several common amenities and services are provided at Student Village . Below are the list of amenities and services available for our residents.



All the **rooms** at Student Village are equipped with bed, chair, study table, wardrobe, mirror, side & wall cabinet, fan and blind. Sharing room have partition and some room equipped with air-conditioner.



All floors have a common **Lounge & Pantry** room with a kitchenette, study area, television, and couches. The kitchenette is equipped with a refrigerator, a microwave & a water dispenser.



Communal **washroom** is available at the centre of each floor. It comes with hot and cold shower.



Located at Student Village 1. **The Central Kitchen** allows residents to cook and prepare their own meals. It comes with several cooking stove, refrigerator, washing basin and storage area. Residents can enjoy their prepared meals at our spacious **Dining Hall**.



**An access card** will be provided to you during check in. You'll need your access card for the main entrance, block entrance and to switch on the air conditioning if you're in a Standard plus room. Residents who lost their access cards should report it to the Accommodation Office and replacement will be made with charges of RM50.00.

**On campus janitor** are available for the daily cleaning at common areas and keeping the hallway clean and comfortable for you. For shared spaces, the cleanliness is the responsibility of all residents.

All residents are required to keep their bedroom clean, hygienic and free from rubbish. **Cleaning equipment** are provided for residents uses.



Residents can store their bikes in area specified by the Accommodation Office. The **Bikes Parking bay** is limited and residents are required to register with the Accommodation Office .

Located at the ground floor, the **Student** 

**Lounge** is designed as a meeting point

Student Village . This area is fitted with

The communal **Laundry** is located at Ground Floor in between Student Village 2 & Student Village 3 block. The 24 hour self-services center comes with washing sinks, coin-operated washing machines, and dryers.



**Mails and Parcels** delivered to Student Village can be collected from Campus Services office at G Building. To receive the mail items, residents can use Student Village address.






#### **Health & Emergency Procedure**

The university is located nearby to several medical facilities, Borneo Medical Centre (it's a 10minute walk from campus) and Timber Medical Centre (It's a 10-minute drive away).
