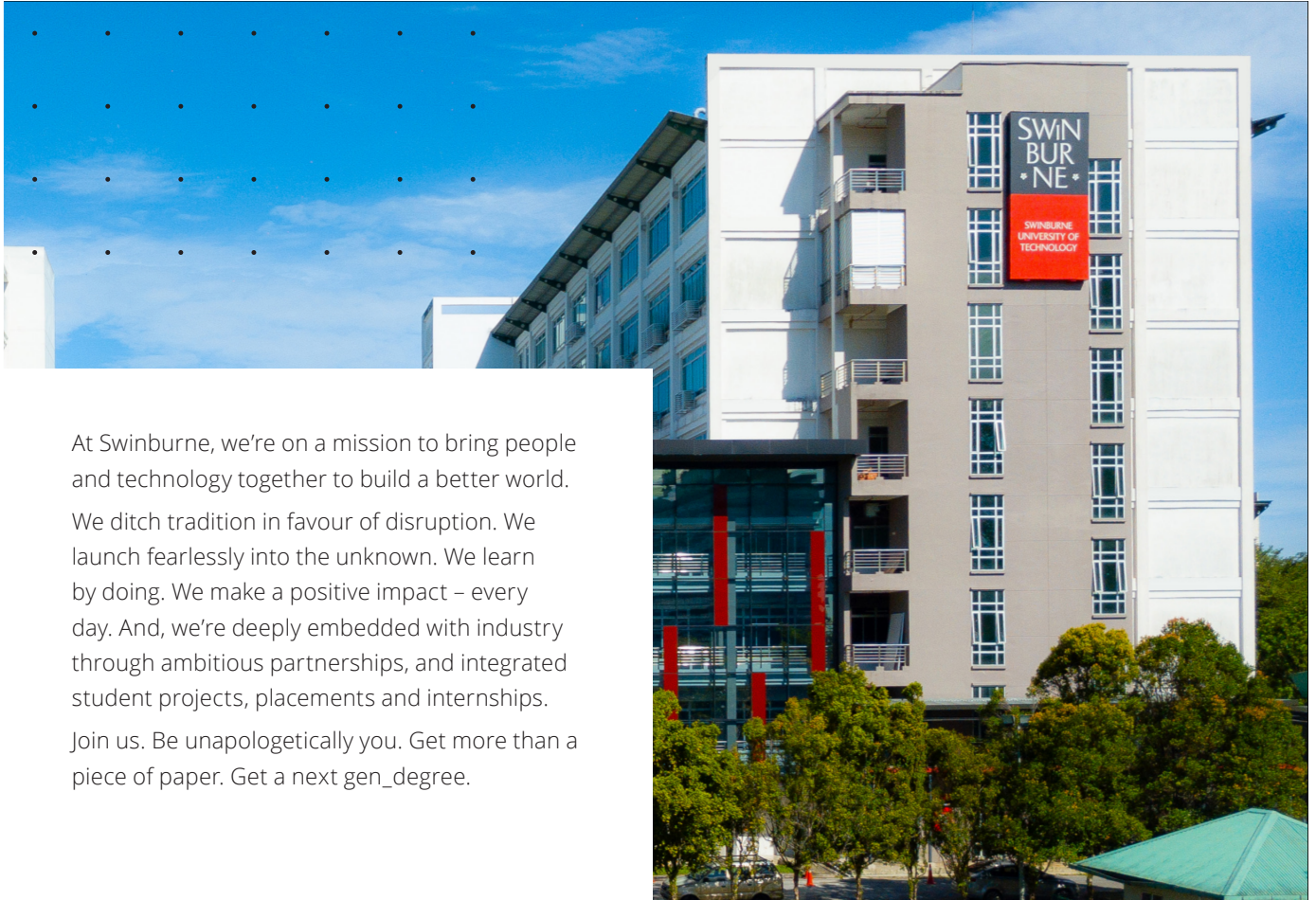

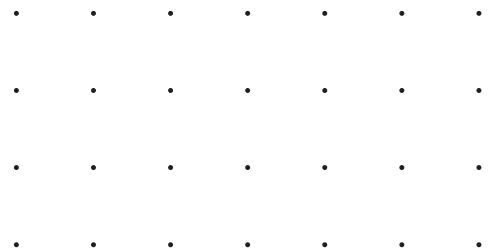

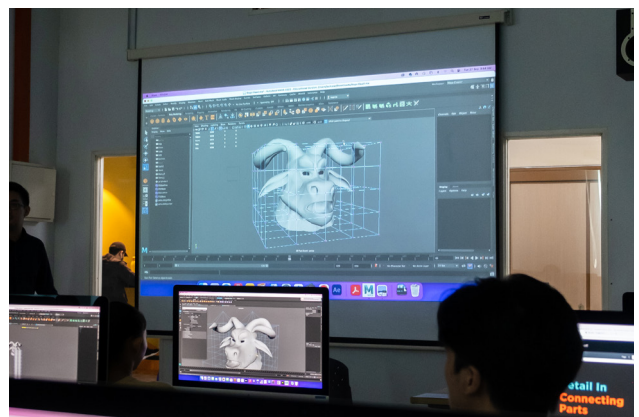


Adobe Creative Campus

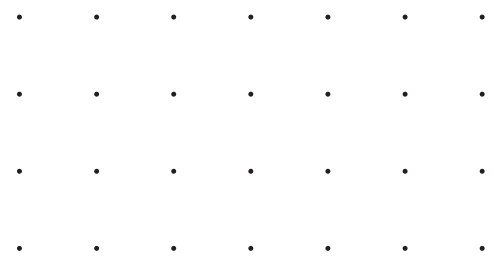

A Quaint and Safe City

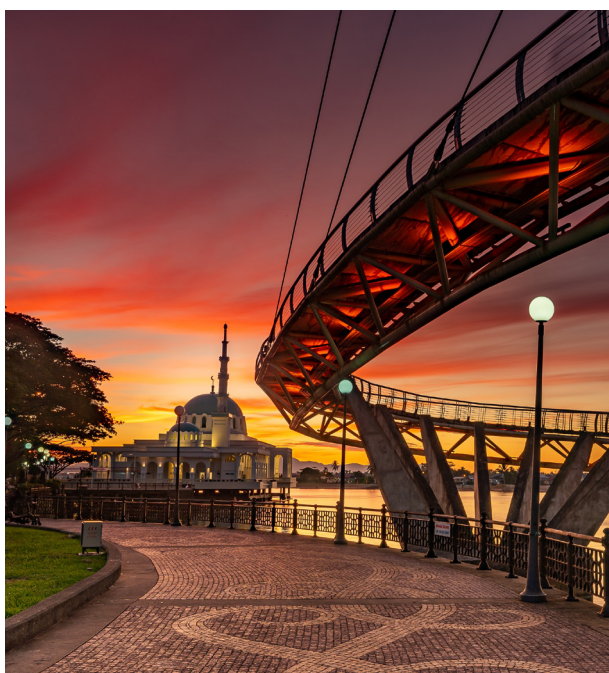

What's in a standard degree?

Our degrees are made up of 24 units of study for a 3-year program and 32 units of study for a 4-year program. A unit is basically another name for a subject and you'll usually take four per semester; eight per year. These units (or subjects) largely fall into one of three categories:

Major units

These specific subjects make up your specialisation, so pick a major you love!

Core units

Students who enrolled in a bachelor degree (regardless of chosen major) will need to complete these units in order to graduate.

Elective units

The remaining units can come from any areas of study. Students may choose to:

- Take all the elective units from your degree program. You'll then end up with a second major;
- Take all the elective units from another program. You'll score a co-major;
- Take four elective units from one area to earn a minor, or
- Mix and match these elective units based on your interest.

ACCA Accelerate Program

The ACCA Accelerate Program is designed to help enhance your qualification when you undertake the ACCA Professional Level examinations. You can enrol into this program in the second year of your undergraduate degree studies.

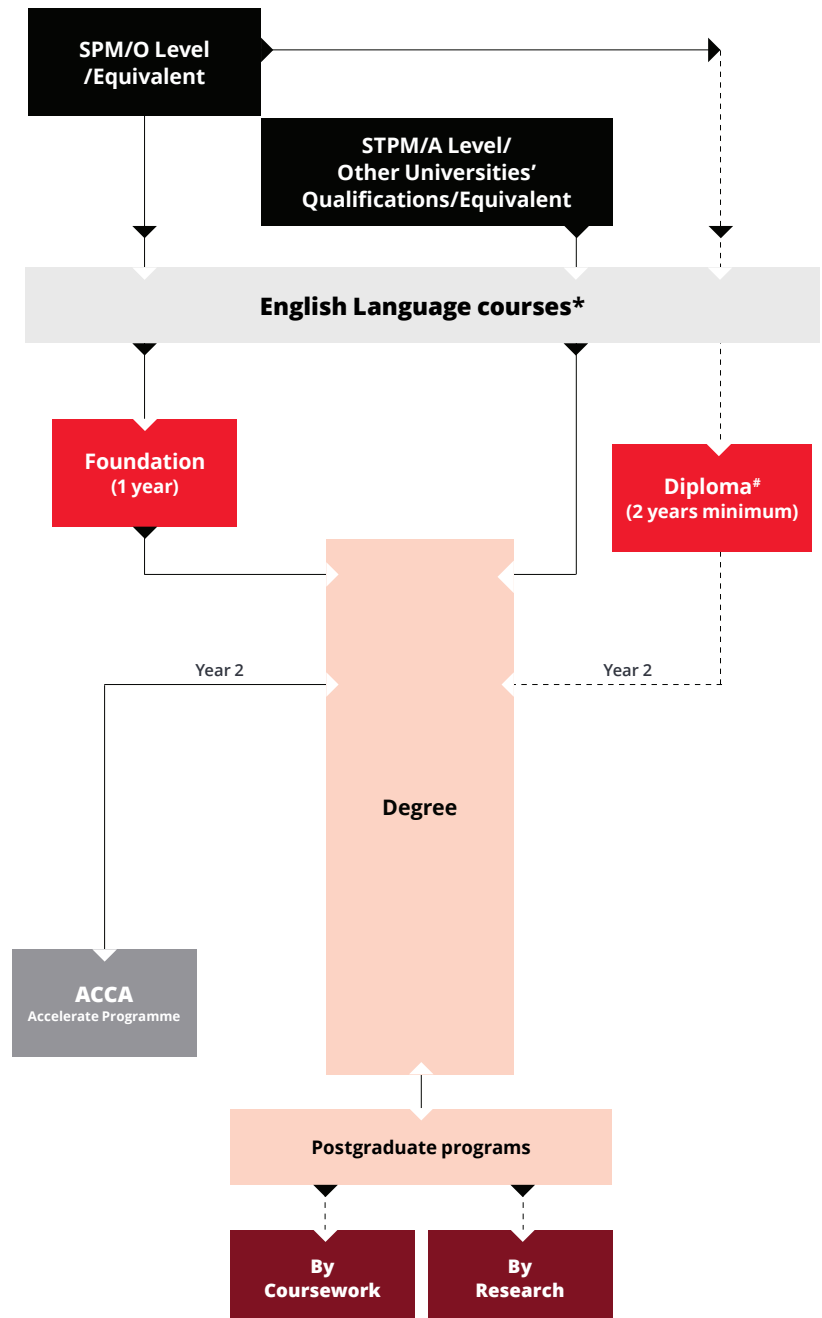
ACCA Dual Diploma

The ACCA Dual Diploma is an option that offers you the opportunity to acquire two certifications through a single course via ACCA's professional Diploma in Accounting and Business (DIAB). With the Dual Diploma option, you complete 18 units of Swinburne's Diploma of Accountancy (DoA) program, and 2 papers from Diploma in Accounting and Business.

Upon completion of the Swinburne diploma, and passing the required Diploma in Accounting and Business paper modules, you will be awarded testamurs for the Swinburne DoA, as well as for the DIAB by ACCA.

With highly qualified and experienced ACCA lecturers, and subjects taught in a conducive learning environment, this gives you a head-start in becoming a qualified professional accountant.

Our degrees take 3 years, Honours degrees 4 years and double degrees 4-5 years. Students can also start the ACCA program in their 2nd year.
